

Asthma Inhalers at School

Memorandum to Parents:

So that the clinic nurse may provide the best care for your child, please submit an asthma action plan, and return to the nurse. If any changes in your child's health status or treatment occur during the year, please notify the nurse.

- Option 1: The student comes to the nurse clinic where the inhaler is kept and uses it under supervision. The advantage is that the medication will be used correctly, in the proper amount, and records will be kept.
- Option 2: *Qualified* students will be allowed to carry their inhalers. This provides immediate accessibility of the inhaler to the student. A spare inhaler provided by the parent can be kept in the clinic should they forget theirs or run out.

Contract between Student, Parent, School Nurse, and Provider

For permission to carry inhalers:

- 1. Student has demonstrated to the nurse correct use of inhaler.
- 2. Student agrees never to share the inhaler with another person.
- 3. Student agrees that after two puffs, if there is not marked improvement, he/she will report to the clinic immediately.
