- Jim Rahn- Thanks Kevin for his and his team's work on the finance end the last few months.
- Jonathan Sanford- Has two questions:
 - Can you elaborate on the grant related to security? Kevin Byrne explains
 that GH TX can draw down \$1.9 million for security improvements. GH
 TX has largely paid for a lot of those projects through the bond funds.
 GH TX will receive that money back from the state and will pay the bond
 money back. This will free up capital for other projects. GHTX will need
 to have security offices at each school for next year and since the state
 has not let us know what funding is available, it creates a bit of pressure
 on the budget.
 - Dr. Sanford is stuck by savings achieved by savings of insourcing from outsourcing. Curious what conditions have changed to achieve such significant saving by bringing these services in house? How will we maintain quality of services by bringing that in house and thinking about this in terms of KPIs as this work is performed.
 - a. It was charged by a per user basis. At a low volume it made sense to outsource. Once we moved over to high volume we discovered that the school was using outdated systems. We now have an IT Coordinator with great experience inside of Texas.
- Kevin Hall-Bond Financing- How do we compare to ISDs in TX. What rates to they get to
 borrow at versus us and why. The permanent school fund was not something we could
 participate in this year because of the TEA investigation. Schools can borrow lower rates
 because they have the ability to tax. Since they are a public agency and can tax, they can
 borrow at a lower rate and we end up paying more to borrow because we are unable to get
 those same rates.
