If, during the course of the meeting, discussion of any item on the agenda should be held in an executive or closed session, the Committee will convene in such executive or closed session as permitted by and in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 551.

Pursuant to Sec. 551.007(b), the Committee will allow members of the public who desire to address the Committee regarding a specific item on the agenda, before or during the Committee's consideration of the item at the meeting. Persons desiring to address the Committee verbally via Microsoft Teams, or in writing may register for public comment or submit their written public comment by emailing Bryan Cornish at bryan.cornish@greatheartstx.org.

The deadline to register to address the Committee is 8:00 a.m. CST on June 3, 2026. The Great Hearts Texas Public Comment agenda item will be limited to 20 minutes in total. Members of the public may have up to two (2) minutes to speak; however, depending on the number of speakers, the board meeting chair may limit the time allotted to fewer than two minutes in order to allow as many registered members of the public to be heard during the agenda item.

The speaking order will be determined on a first-come, first-served basis and according to the timestamp of when the individual registers. No individual presentation shall exceed two (2) minutes. In the event an individual uses a non-simultaneous translator when addressing the Board, the individual shall be permitted twice the allotted time to make his or her presentation.
